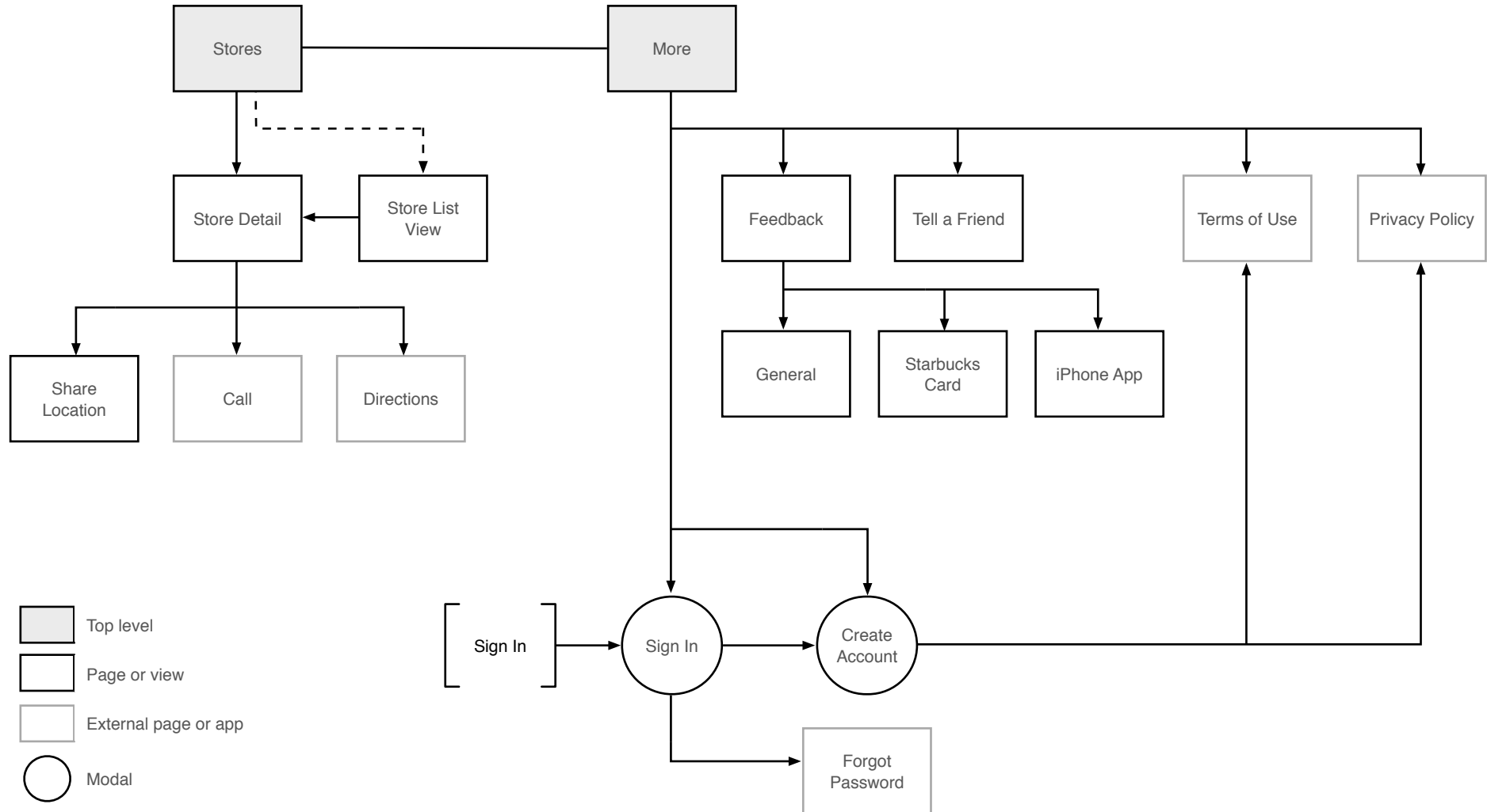
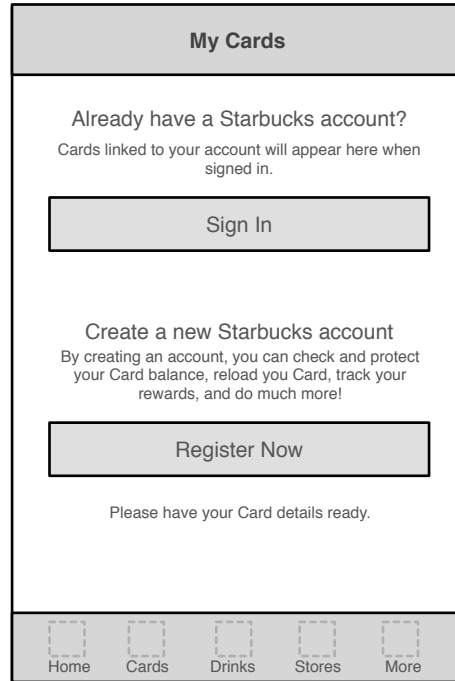


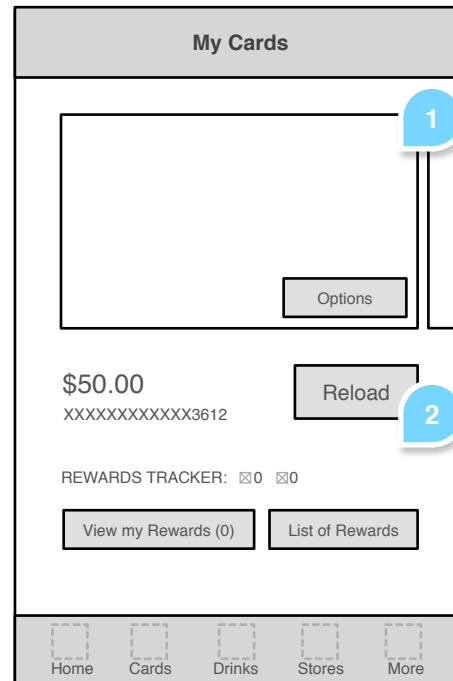
Sitemap



2. Cards



If user is not signed in, he will be asked to Sign In or Register.



If user is signed in, he will be able to see his cards in the Cards view.

- 1 The image is the actual image on the matching Starbucks Card.

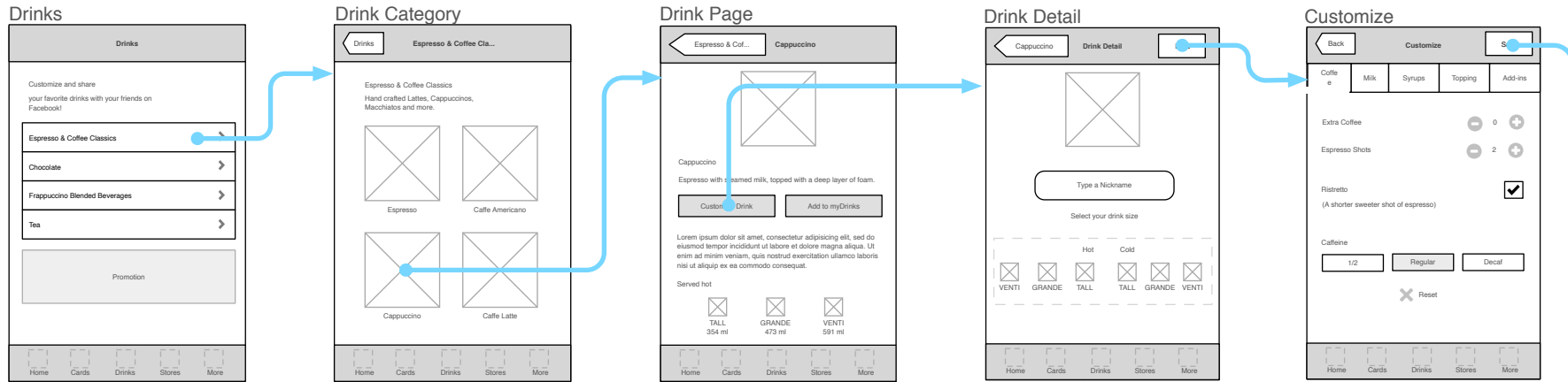
User can drag/swipe the Card to load the next or previous Card in the list. A small portion of the next/previous Cards will peek through at the edges to show that there are Cards before or after this one.
- 2 This area will be updated with the selected Card's details:
 - Current value
 - Card number or nickname
 - Reward Tracker counts

Whenever the Starbucks Card number is displayed, the number is hidden except for the last four digits:
XXXXXXXXXXXX3612

If the card has a nickname, the nickname and last four digits are displayed:
Ken (3612)

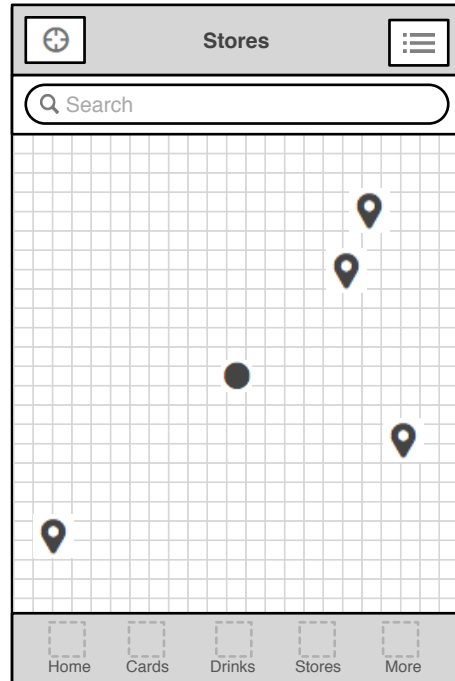
A. Customizing a Drink



B. Editing a Saved Drink



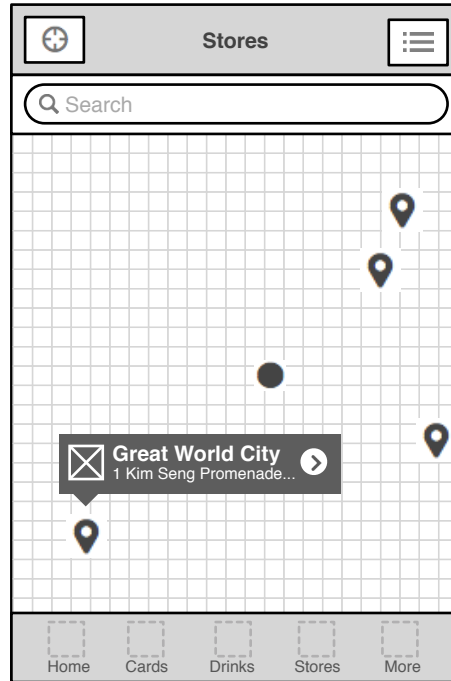
4. Stores



On load, centers on the user's location. Shows pins where Starbucks Stores are located.

The Locate button will center the map on the user again.

The List button will open the Store List View

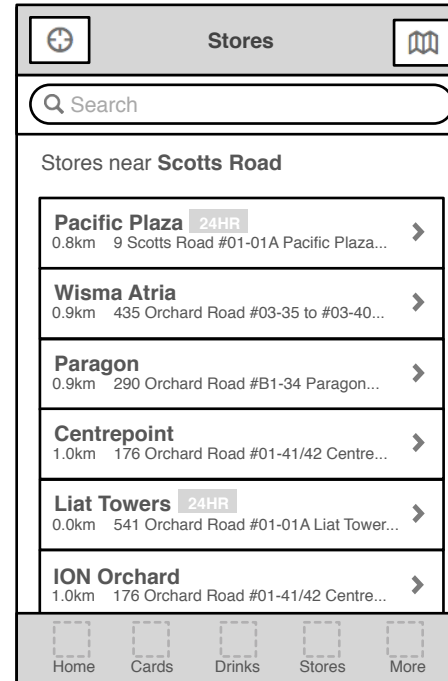


Tapping on the pins will bring up a tooltip with:

- Starbucks logo
- Store name
- address (truncated to fit)

Tapping on the arrow will bring up the Store Details

4.1. Stores List View

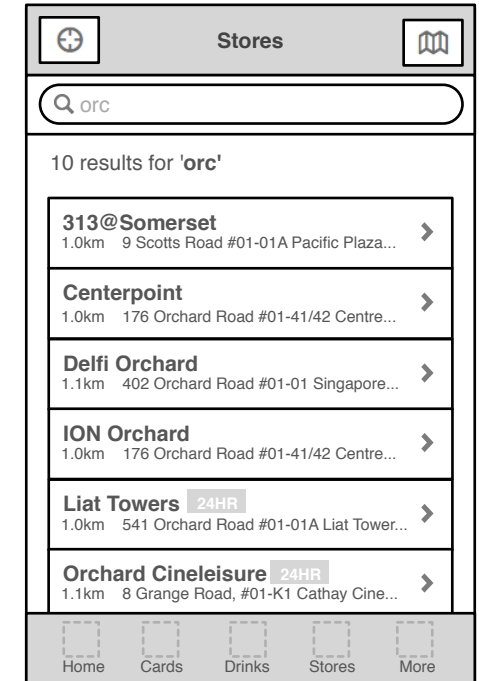


List view shows:

- Store name
- 24hr label if applicable
- distance from user (rounded to 0.1 km)
- address (truncated to fit)

Items are sorted by distance.

The Locate and Map buttons will return to the Stores Map View.



The user can search for a Store. The list will update for every character typed in the search field.
